
# Insight of the Month: Disability & Mental Health



## DID YOU KNOW?

In 2021, almost a third of OU Association students surveyed, identified that they have some form of disability (over 10% more than in 2020\*).

The pandemic has seen a sharp rise in mental health issues and the OU Students Association has the largest single community of disabled students in Europe...but what does this mean in practice?

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME?

To find out more about how best to improve the student experience for all, the 2021 [Annual Membership Survey](#) expanded the categories for students to identify as 'disabled'. These included: physical impairment; mental impairment; and neuro-diverse.
