### Society and Club numbers and membership

- 3.1 As of January 2025 there are 15 societies currently listed as affiliated on the Association website with a total membership of 7 557. We are pleased to report that the Geological Society have recently re-affiliated to the Association. Unfortunately, the Space Society have now been disaffiliated from the Association.
- 3.2 In addition, there are 22 clubs currently listed with a combined total membership of 12 404 students. We have 2 newly registered clubs the International Students Club and the Vegan Club.
