### Introduction

1.1 The EDI and Student Welfare Team would like to update the Student Leadership Team on work towards our EDI objectives and provide an update from our current support Groups.

# Updates from the EDI and Belonging Team

- 2.1 Cases for the Individual Reputation service continue to grow but unfortunately, we said farewell and good luck to Charlotte who left the team to join the Citizens Advice Bureau. We are hoping to recruit for another adviser soon.
- 2.2 Library Study Volunteer requests have hit 700 since the service began in 2019 and we continue to get positive feedback from both volunteers and users. Our most recent feedback was from a user who had submitted a request 3-6 times and when we asked 'How has using this service helped you?' They ticked 'made me feel less isolated', 'made me feel better equipped to study', that it 'offered me

study support for key stages' and 'to have people invest time in my studies has made me feel encouraged'. In the free text they also noted that 'material sent has always given me a different angle to DA223 set text authors'.

- 2.3 After the soft launch of OU Students Connect (the Aluminate platform) to Group members there was also a small launch through September Welcome Week. We have mostly concentrated advertising the platform with Groups although the SLT have done a great job in sharing with Faculties and their own community spaces. Within Groups we had a target of 15% Group member take up by January and I can confirm the current numbers are:
  - BAME Group 45 (28%)
  - DSG 240 (24%)
  - OU Pride 88 (22%)
- 2.4 Group Committee Appointments were really successful with just a few remaining Committee members left to train. Reports from each are below as usual.
- 2.5 We did our bi-ennial Engagement Survey for Students in Secure Environments in the summer and were delighted to receive 242 responses from students. Responses indicate that we can do more to advertise our Library Study Volunteer service as 145 respondents were unaware of the service. A further evaluation of the findings will be shared in due course.
- 2.6 We are busy finalising the Neurodivergent Students Action Plan which can feed directly into the new SLT Priority project. This too will be shared in a longer report soon.
- 2.7 The 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the SiSE Newsletter has been sent for printing this week and will be posted to our website for others to read in the coming weeks. The latest edition took on board feedback from the summer survey and will be trying to include more relevant topics for the readers such as general interest topics (e.g history) and study skills.
