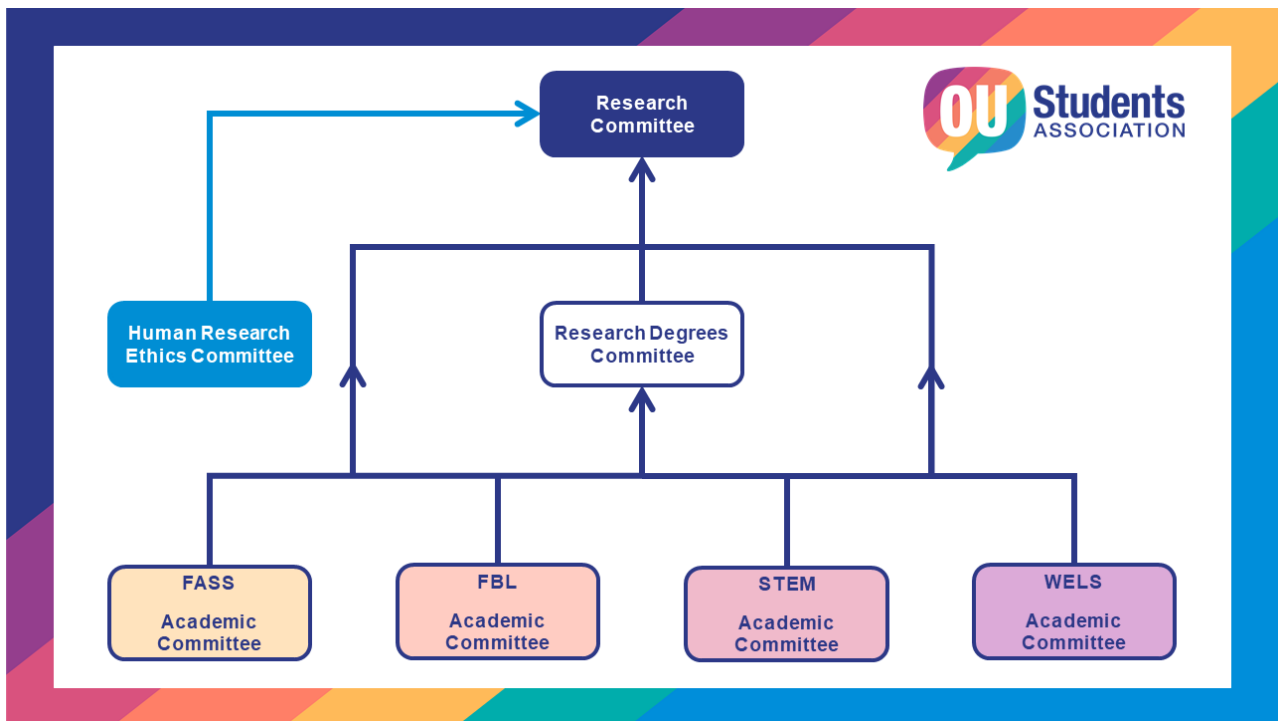


What do all these committees do?



Research Committee

This committee has overall responsibility for research strategy and policy at the OU, as well as oversight of matters relating to research degrees and ethics.

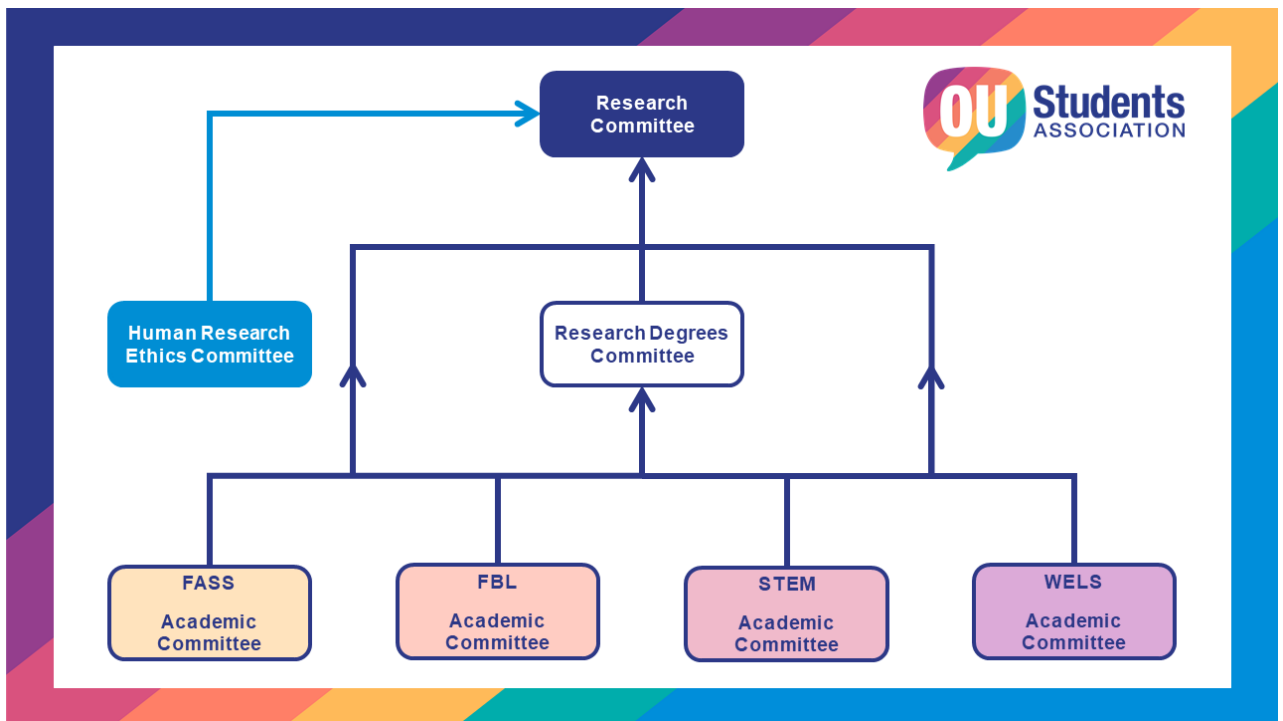
Are you interested in how research is governed at a UK university or developing your research career? Research Committee needs your expertise

Research Degrees Committee

This committee regulates all policy, regulations, and procedures relating to research degrees and therefore has a big impact on the experience of postgraduate research students. It reports directly to Research Committee.

Faculty Academic Committees (Research)

Each faculty (FASS, FBL, STEM, and WELS) has an academic committee to oversee research strategy, policy, and delivery across its different subject areas. They report to both Research Committee and Research Degrees Committee

Human Research Ethics Committee

This committee has the important duty giving ethical consideration to all OU research proposals involving humans. It reports directly to Research Committee
